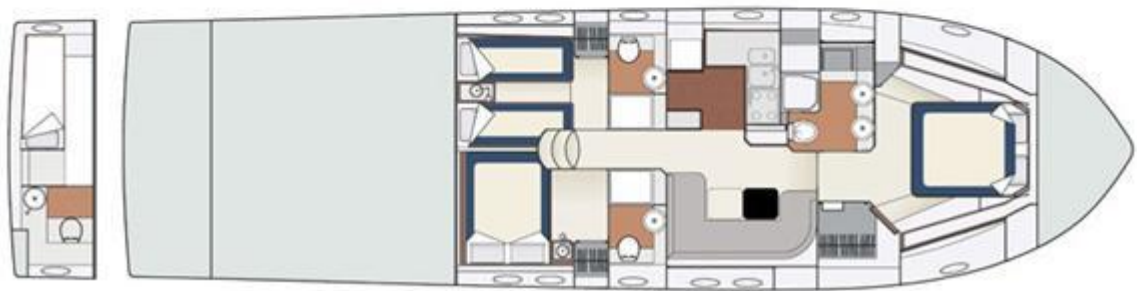
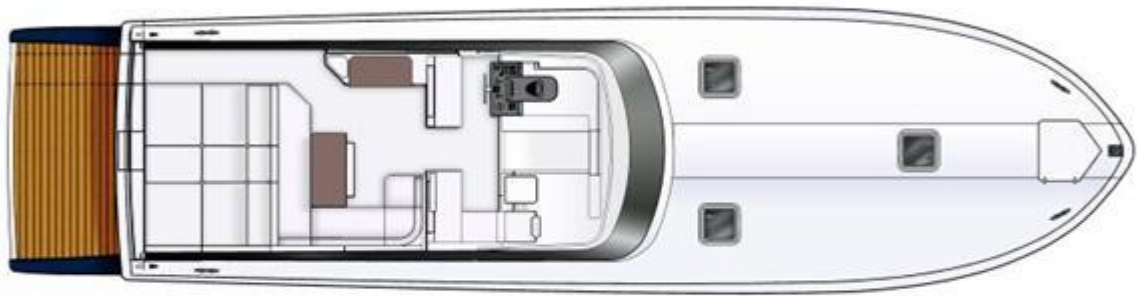

FEATURES

Above deck : The Itama 55 is quite simply the epitome of elegance. Her breathtaking lines, elongated bow and streamlined, smoked windshield are superb and the overall silhouette is so smooth that at first sight the access to the fore sundeck seems invisible. At the stern, the impressive teak bathing platform on hydraulic jacks can be used to effortlessly launch a tender with access from the platform to the cockpit passing by a large sundeck to starboard. In the center of the cockpit lies an on-deck saloon facing a small galley. The helm station is well positioned behind the windshield, with two bench seats on either side of the boat and a magnificent dashboard at once futuristic and retro, and a beautifully designed helm.

Below Deck : The Itama 55 may be beautiful on the outside, she is none the less stunning below deck. A successful combination of light and dark woods, chrome and stainless steel creates a highly contemporary feel and the impeccable finishings give a kind of understated elegance and efficiency. The master cabin is in the bow, with the guest cabins in the centre of the boat on either side of the companion way : a double berth to starboard and the twin berths to port. Each cabin has its own bathroom. In between the guest cabins and the owner's cabin is a well-designed and nicely equipped galley and a large saloon.
